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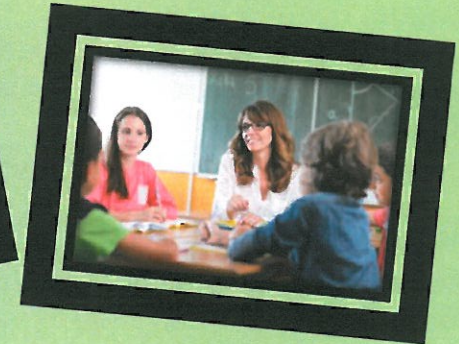

Reading Interventions - Strategies and Scaffolds for the Close Reading Process

Designed for teachers eager to learn strategies for introducing and scaffolding the close reading process for whole class and small group settings. Practice best first instruction with content-area text and support a rich informational text-based curriculum.

Participants will:

- Dive into the Common Core State Standards and literacy capacities through the four phases of Close Reading.
- Discover how to evaluate text for levels of complexity.
- Apply the close reading process across diverse text and media types.
- Align text-dependent questions to access informational text for various purposes and depths of understanding.
- Engage in small-group, hands-on activities that link reading to authentic writing tasks.

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Writing Interventions - A Systematic Approach to the Writing Process

Teachers will explore the reading-writing connection and learn a unique instructional strategy that accommodates struggling readers and language learners. By building a systematic approach to the writing process, teachers can use formative assessment practices to provide appropriate scaffolds, and help even resistant writers to feel successful.

Participants will:

- Define characteristics of text types.
- Learn how to write from the inside out.
- Discover tips for adding appropriate openings and closings.
- See how to engage students in authentic revision for vocabulary and grammar.
- Learn progress monitoring and assessment through the portfolio process.

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Math Interventions - Activities to Enhance Mathematical Thinking

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MTSS - A New Framework to Support Student Success
